John Hartung: John reported to the Board that the Patrons are in the CIN Database and the barcodes are ready to be put on the books. John also explained that Kari Wilson from the Hayden Branch will be coming up in August to give instruction for the staff to put on barcodes on the Books. **UPDATE:** The Grant was budgeted for \$ 8,200.00 for part of a process for working with the records. It turns out it was optional and not mandated. CIN chose not to exercise that and put the \$8,200.00 back in the budget and all of our supplies will be covered by the Grant. Our new lower payment is \$441.04 instead of \$780.00 quarterly. There is now match due on this it is all coming out of the grant. We will not be paying for patron card or barcodes for the first year. CIN (Cooperative Information Network) is the largest Library Consortium in Idaho. John also shared that our biblical graphic records are now being put into the CIN database at Gonzaga. Our annual fee will be \$1000.00for CIN (\$500.00 a workstation with a Minimum of 2 work stations) The \$1000.00 includes everything Membership fees for CIN and the software but does not include the Courier. Barbi let John know that we only budgeted for the next fiscal year \$300.00 for the membership, because the grant will pay for part of it. John let us know that our first fiscal year will be starting 2011. Shannon and Rachel from Gonzaga are doing our data entry of book records right now.

Terry Blessing: Presented the Board of Trustees a Power Point Presentation from the Public Works Division of Building Safety and go over the Basics over Public works contract. Jody stated she would like

to have Terry come and give classes to the local contractors. Terry handed the board some booklets and pamphlets to give out to any contractor who asked for them.(see attached)
